- ★ When *Solo* is a priority, all other priorities in your life will fall into their correct position. The urgent will no longer usurp the important.

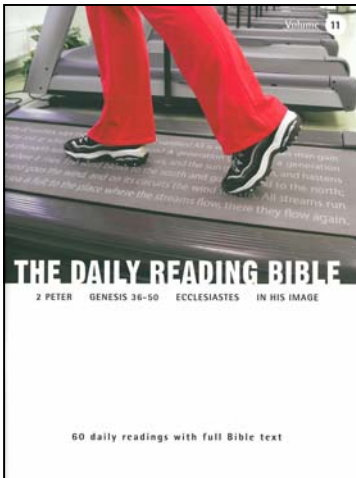
It is time to get back into regular Bible reading.

BIBLE is one small book with all you need to get you traveling well.



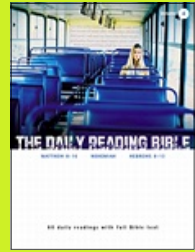

A sustainable routine enables us to meditate on his Word and how it will infuse our lives. Praying about how to

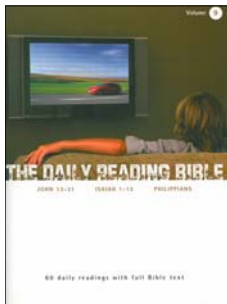


live it out every day will bring these truths to mind regularly, and bend our hearts towards God's heart.



Hong Kong is busy. And most of us are tired. We all struggle with the lack of time, energy and motivation to read God's word on a regular basis. And Satan would have us fail. He would have us avoid God and be spiritually distanced, be influenced by the world around us and feel disillusioned. But it doesn't need to be like that.

The key to **Solo** is getting started.



Making **Solo** a priority will involve sacrifice, discipline and strategy.

We are called to be disciples – to follow Jesus, not ourselves or



anything else that would demand our time. We can stay fresh in our faith when we cultivate the desire for knowledge and a deeper relationship with God through **Solo** and small group settings, to dive into his Word and uncover the treasures our Father has for us.

“How sweet are your words to my taste,” says the psalmist about the law of God, “sweeter than honey to my mouth” (Ps 119:103). Most Christians would acknowledge that the Bible is indeed the sweet and satisfying word of God, but somehow it doesn't always feel this way. Too often, reading the Bible feels like our attempts to have regular exercise - a healthy chore we know we should fit in, but which is hard to manage amongst everything else, and ends up slipping off the agenda.

The research on Bible reading among contemporary Christians certainly doesn't make very happy reading. If there are ten

people in your group, six of them either never read the Bible or do so only very occasionally. A further two read the Bible once a week or a few times a week. Only two of the ten read the Bible every day, or most days.

Why is it like this? Is it lack of motivation? Lack of discipline? Lack of knowing where to start? Lack of confidence?
