Mission at St Andrew's

As a church, we partner with different mission organisations to help meet the material and spiritual needs of people in Hong Kong and around the world. Let's prayerfully consider how we can each use the skills and opportunities, time and energy that God has given us to serve Him and His people.

Serving Ethnic Minorities

From their centre in Yau Ma Tei, Inner City Ministries (ICM) serve the South Asian (especially Nepalese) community in Hong Kong. Once a month a St Andrew's team leads the afternoon kids club with songs, Bible stories, games and crafts. Other volunteering opportunities include helping with the homework club or teaching Cantonese to children.

Serving the Disabled

The Home of Loving Faithfulness (HOLF) is a friendly residential home in Sheung Shui for children and adults with special needs. If more volunteers sign up than we need for cooking, the team can serve by painting decorations for the sensory garden that the HOLF residents so enjoy.

Serving the Elderly

Once a month, a team from St Andrew's visits elderly people who live alone in To Kwa Wan. These are precious opportunities to befriend the elderly, bless them with gifts (e.g., toiletries or festive foods) and share the gospel with them. Visits happen on Saturday afternoons at 2-4pm. The next visit with training for new team members happens on 16 March, with other visits on 13 April, 11 May, 8 June, 13 July, 31 August, 28 September, 26 October and 14 December.
