God's heart is to seek and save the lost, and he invites us to join in with his mission. As a church, we are glad to partner with Christian organisations that share the love of Jesus in words and action here in Hong Kong and around the world. Let's prayerfully consider how we can use the gifts that God has given us to serve him and his people.

Serving Ethnic Minorities

From their centre in Yau Ma Tei, Inner City Ministries serve the Nepalese community in Hong Kong, many of whom come from Hindu or Buddhist backgrounds. Once a month, our church team helps run the Kids Club with singing, Bible stories, games and crafts. There are also opportunities to help primary school children learn Cantonese, and secondary school pupils with their homework.

Serving People with Special Needs

Home of Loving Faithfulness is a friendly residential home near Sheung Shui for children and adults with special needs. Volunteers can serve by cooking and baking, telling stories, doing arts and crafts, singing and playing music. Opportunities to serve outdoors include gardening, painting garden furniture or pushing wheelchairs so the residents can enjoy the sensory garden or a day out off site.

Serving Prisoners

The HK Christian Kun Sun Association serves prison inmates, rehabilitated persons and their families with the good news of Jesus. The St Andrew's prison visitation teams are quite full but volunteers who can teach interest classes (e.g., art, music, fitness and dance) are welcome. Writing letters is a great way to share the gospel with prison inmates and to encourage them in their faith. Training will be provided.

Based in Chungking Mansions, Christian Action Centre for Refugees serves refugees and asylum seekers in Hong Kong by providing practical help. Volunteers who can tutor primary and secondary school pupils in different subjects, especially Maths and Science, are welcome.

Serving the Vulnerable

Sons & Daughters helps those at risk of or survived sexual exploitation and trafficking rebuild their lives in Christ. We hope to launch an outreach team to Chungking Mansions with volunteers committed to serving two evenings a month. Training will be provided. Volunteers are also needed to help with social media, writing newsletters and organising fundraising events.

Serving in the Philippines

Serving in Southeast Asia
