Purpose and Goal:

To cultivate faith growing opportunities amongst a select group of young people by exposing them to a culture outside of their area of comfort and providing direct discipleship by:

- ◇ Helping them fundraise (and relying on God for the funds)
- ◇ Opening their worldview to missions around the world
- ◇ Praying with locals
- ◇ Sharing the gospel with locals through acts of love and Word
- ◇ Supplying practical and spiritual needs to the missionaries
- ◇ Building relationships with one another as Christian brothers and sisters on the field

Where:

We will be visiting Home for the 100th Sheep, run by Kaloï and Edna, mission partners of St. Andrews. Fusion Youth have visited numerous times in the past on mission, and it's wonderful that we are able to do so again this year!

What is Home for the 100th Sheep?

The organization is a not-for-profit pre-school for underprivileged children in the Philippines. St. Andrews mission partners, Kaloï & Edna Ranario

established the school in 2002 after residing in Hong Kong for 11 years. An action of love to help our government's desire to diminish if not eliminate the growing number of street children in the country.

Travel Details

We will be going for 6 days and 5 nights from the 15th April to 20th April. From HKG International Airport, we will fly into Manila Airport. From there we will be met by Kaloï (missionary) who will take us via taxi to Violets Resort Hotel, Cavite, where we will stay for the duration of our time there.

Each day, we will take taxi's to and from Home for the 100th Sheep.

How will we serve?

Ultimately, we are at the mercy of our mission partners. We want to serve them in the way that helps them most. Mission isn't about doing our own thing, but serving the wider kingdom.

That said, we could expect to do a number of things whilst there:

Working with children during school time.

Taking children on a school outing.

Running afternoon youth clubs.

Painting School buildings.

Enjoying fellowship together and with the home of 100 sheep.

Visiting and participating with a local church.

A full and more accurate schedule will be sent to participants before we leave.

In our preparation for going – we may learn some action songs that can share a Bible message, learn a drama and learn games to play with youth so that we can be better equipped to spend time and share Jesus.

Will we have down-time?

Although a short-term mission trip is not a holiday, we will have time to relax each evening. The hotel we are staying at has a large pool to enjoy at the end of each day.

Important Information

Please read and understand the following, important information.

Financial Commitment:

If accepted, you are required to fund the full financial cost of your trip. This will be completed in two payments of a deposit and the remainder of the cost at a later date.

\$2000 – 10th Feb (deposit)

\$ 4500 – 17th March (remainder)*

*This amount will be adjusted accordingly when total fundraising has been accounted for and you will be made aware of total amount before 17th March.

\$6500 Total Cost per student*

*This is an estimated total cost. Final total costs will be adjusted when total number of students, and associated costs have been paid for and fundraising accounted for.

Fundraising Commitment:

As a team, we will be fundraising to ease the burden. Fundraising is a great way to help you to learn how missionaries survive. To fundraise we will do a couple of church events, as well as provide students with ways to inform family and friends and ask for personal donations.

Even if you are able to pay for your share of the journey, you are still required to be at fundraising events as our trip is a team effort, and shows that we are servants together helping one another for God's Kingdom.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that you cannot attend a mission trip and need to cancel, please keep in mind the following:

- Deposits are always non-refundable and non-transferable.
- In the event that your trip includes airfare, bus tickets, or any other related trip expense that our church must allocate funds for earlier than the day balances are due, then you will be held responsible for that cost, no matter when you cancel.

Exceptions: If we can fill your spot from our waiting list, you have the options:

- We can send you a refund for the remaining amount after the deposit.
- You may contribute your refund towards the Mission Team's General Fund
- If there is no waiting list, there is no possibility of any type of refund.

Visa Requirements

Parents of children 15 years and younger must have completed the **AFFIDAVIT OF CONSENT AND SUPPORT** form that accompanies this paperwork, as well as complete all the requirements listed in the **WAIVER OF EXCLUSION GROUND (WEG)** and processed it in a timely matter through the Philippine Consulate, and should be prepared to cover all costs associated with this form.

All parents must ensure that their child holds a valid passport, and are eligible to enter the Philippines. You can see if your country is eligible here:

Mission Trip Contract

Dear Student and Parents,

Below you will find a list of commitments that both student and parent need to agree to in order that we ensure our mission trip is a success. If there is anything below that you cannot agree to, then this trip isn't for you. Please remember that our trip to the Philippines is not a holiday, but an opportunity to serve.

That said we are looking forward to a great week of loving and serving our mission partners (Kaloi and Edna of Home for the 100th Sheep) in their ministry.

On this trip, we will Go, Give and Grow.

Go: We're going to go out of our comfort zones, being obedient to the great commission (Matt. 28).

Give: We're going to give of ourselves financially, physically and mentally as we serve our mission partners to share the good news of Jesus.

Grow: We will grow in our faith as we are pushed to do things we haven't done before, and trusting in Jesus to use us to do His will.

By being a part of this team I commit to the following:

Pursuing Jesus: I commit to a lifestyle that is pursuing a life like Jesus and trying to live according to 1 Peter 1:16, "Be holy because I am holy." I recognize that I'm not perfect, but I will live a life that points to Jesus and will flee from impurity, selfishness and immorality. I commit to asking for help and accountability when needed.

Mandatory Dates & Trainings: I commit to attend all mandatory dates & training sessions.

Fundraising: I commit to all fundraising activities that will help the collective cost of our as well as to provide much needed resources for those we are going to serve.

Required Materials and Preparedness: I commit to bringing all of my required materials to each training, which may include: books, paperwork, fundraising letters, etc. I commit to meeting all deadlines lined out for me. I understand and agree that neither **St. Andrew's Church**, nor its Trustees, Directors, Employees and Volunteers may be held liable in any way for any injury, harm, damage or death that may occur to me as a result of my participation in this short-term mission trip and hereby release **St. Andrew's Church**, its Trustees, Directors, Employees and Volunteers from any injury, harm, damage or death, which may occur while I am participating in the short-term mission trip.

I authorize **St. Andrew's Church** through its Trustees, Directors, Employees and Volunteers to render or obtain such emergency medical care or treatment for me as may be necessary should any injury, harm or accident occur to me while participating in the mission trip/retreat.

Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG)

To all parents of children 15 years and younger, please read the following important information which can be found at: <http://www.hongkongpcg.dfa.gov.ph/2014-02-27-11-28-41/2014-03-25-07-31-33> under **Waiver of Exclusion Ground(WEG)**.

Waiver of Exclusion Ground(WEG) Under Sec. 29 (a)(12) of the Philippine Immigration Act

For the information of all concerned, children below 15 years old who are holding foreign passports may travel to the Philippines if they are (1) accompanied by parent/s or (2) traveling to meet their parent/s in the Philippines. Those who are traveling to the Philippines unaccompanied by or not meeting their parent/s in the Philippines must apply for a Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG) under Sec. 29 (a) (12) of the Philippines Immigration Act.

The Bureau of Immigration started implementing new procedures on the WEG, which may be applied for before or upon arrival.

As a parent of a 15 year old or younger child, you will need to complete the following procedure in order for your child to join us.

Procedure for WEG application before arrival

The minor's parents, guardian or legal representative should notify the Commissioner of Immigration in writing (xinfo@immigration.gov.ph) of the minor's intent to travel to Philippine at least 72 hours before the arrival

The Letter of Intent should include a request for the minor's waiver of exclusion and the relinquishment of exclusion fees together with copies of the following requirements:

- Copies of the minor's valid passport and visa (if required).
- Copies of return ticket,
- Clear copy of child's birth certificate,
- Affidavit of Consent (blank forms are available at this Consulate) from both parents or either parent, guardian or legally representative of the child, naming the person who will be accompanying the child to the Philippines duly notarized by the Philippine Consulate, and
- Copies of the data page of passport of the accompanying adult, where applicable.

The Commissioner of Immigration shall issue an Order after assessment of the request that waives the minor's exclusion and even the fees. The minor's parents, guardian or legal representative shall be given copies of the Order.

The Commissioner of Immigration shall send a copy of the Order to the Immigration Duty Supervisor (IDS) at the port of entry. This order shall waive the minor's exclusion and, if allowed also the fees' waiver.

Notes:

To have the Affidavit of Consent notarized by this Consulate, the parent/s, guardian or legal representative of the child must come personally to the Philippine Consulate, present their Hong Kong ID card or passport (original and photocopy) and two (2) recent photographs of the child, and pay the notarial fee of HK\$200.00. Processing period in two (2) working days following the date of the application. (please see downloadable forms)

Procedure for WEG applications upon arrival

WEG shall be signed and approved by the appropriate immigration authorities upon the child's arrival at the Philippine port of entry, subject to the submission of the abovementioned requirements and payment of WEG fee (Php 3,120).

This will need to be completed at least 72 hours before your child joins us.

In order to complete the form, you will need the passport details of the primary adult accompanying your minor on the trip (Darren Pollock), as he will be the accompanying adult and the one responsible for your child whilst abroad. You will also need a copy of your return tickets, which will be available once all airfare has been booked and paid for.

When you are ready to send your documents, email darren@standrews.org.hk so that he may send you a passport copy so that you may complete this form.
